Philip Kwok is a Partner of JunHe's Hong Kong Office. In addition to his practice achievements, Philip is also the first batch graduate from the E-Commerce Law stream of the Juris Master degree of Peking University, when he participated in various research projects on e-commerce regulatory matters commissioned by the PRC Ministry of Commerce and the National People's Congress Finance and Economic Committee. He is currently a Member of the InnoTech Committee and the Privacy and Data Law Committee of the Law Society of Hong Kong. He is also a Lecturer (Non-Clinical) of the Faculty of Law, the University of Hong Kong, responsible for the China Information Technology and Electronic Commerce Law course for primarily Master of Laws and Juris Doctor students for over 7 consecutive years. Lately, he is also responsible for editing the 2024 edition of Halsbury's Laws of Hong Kong on Information Privacy and Confidentiality.
